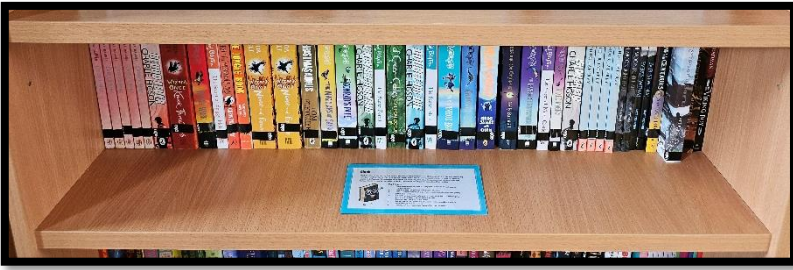
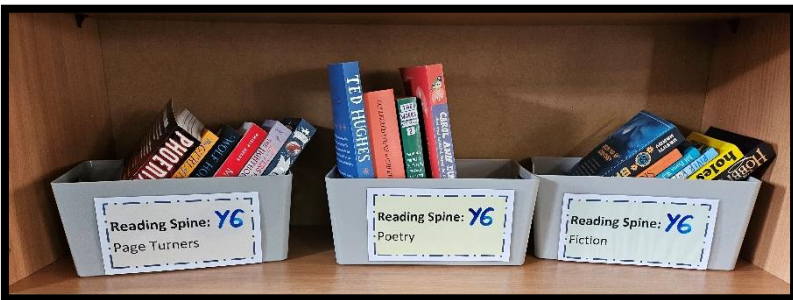


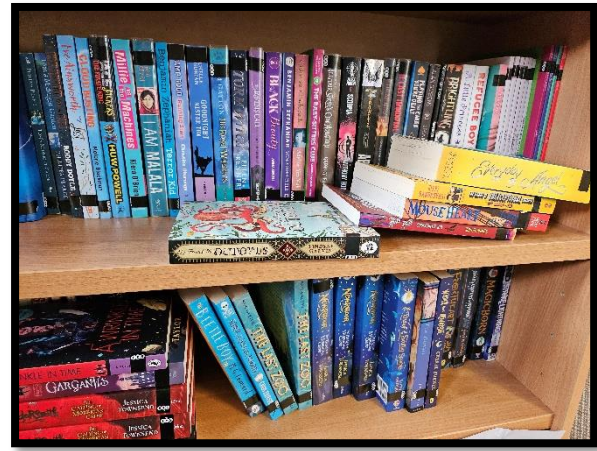
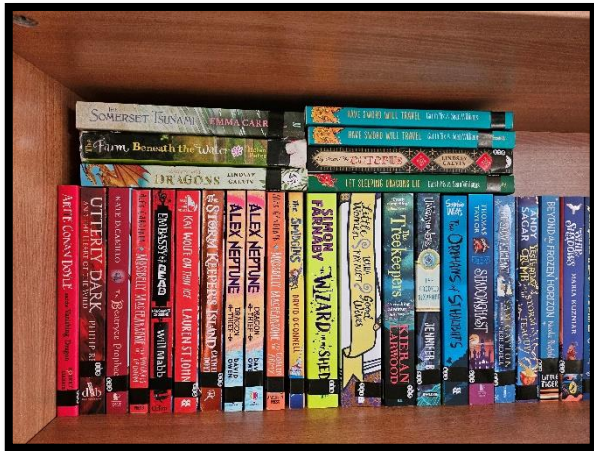
KS2 reading, book shelf rules and procedures 2024



Choose a reading for pleasure 'free reading' book from your banded colour area... **or**...



A 'Reading Spine' book from your 'year group' section!



When you return books, they **MUST** go back where you got them from neatly!

They will either be put back into the box where you got it from or put onto the shelf - you can stack on top...

...but **NOT** like this!

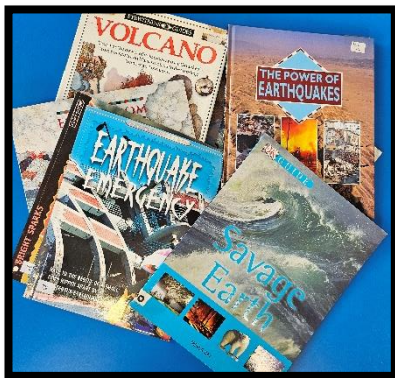


You should also take a 'decodable book' from your number level...

So, you will have 2 books to take home every day!



Remember - to use your wallet to keep books in!



Each classroom also has a selection of 'Non-Fiction topic' books that you could take home to share with an adult.

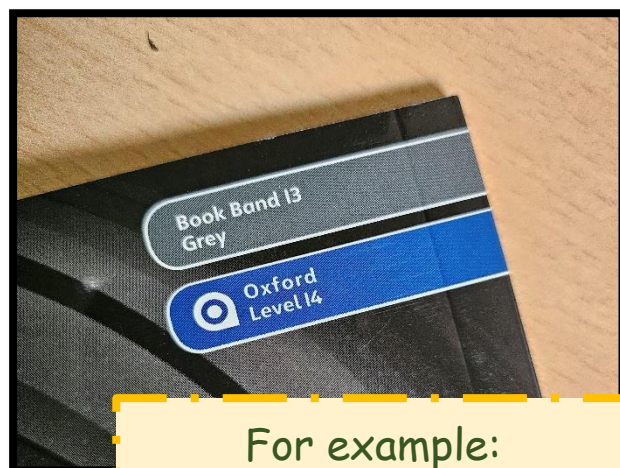
There are also many more books in each classroom you can choose for your 'reading for pleasure book'!



Check you have the correct book!

The **colour** at the **top** is the colour band.

The **number** at the **bottom** is the number.

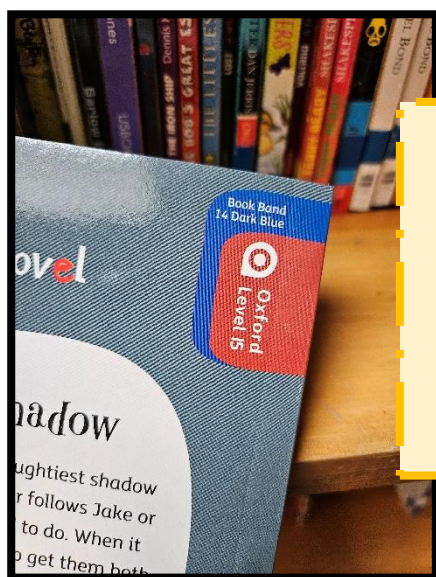


For example:

Ask your teacher if you have forgotten your log in details!

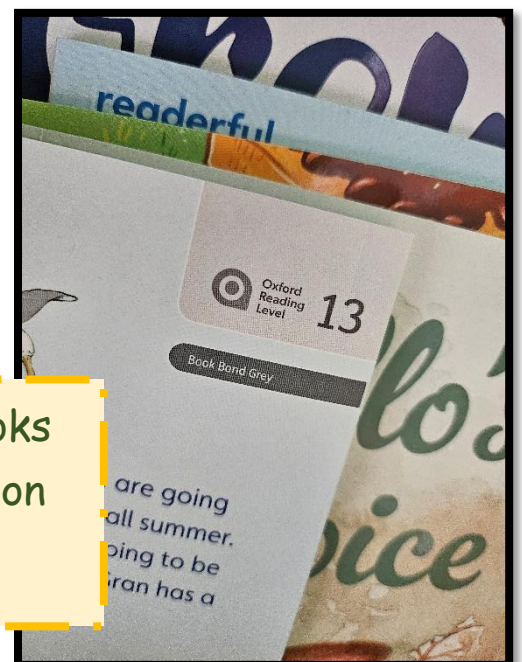
Some children will be directed to use the 'Readerful' books.
