## Parental Survey May 2025

Thank you to all the parents who have completed the Parental Survey. We had 39 responses which is 19% of the school.

We have had many positive responses and the overall feedback is resoundingly encouraging. We have also had some comments for improvements, so I will try and answer as many as I can.

### Comments for Improvement

#### *Teaching about how to stop bullying/bad behaviour*

This is part of our PSHE curriculum. Senior Leaders are out on the playground every day to support the children who find playtimes and lunchtime tricky. Parents and school working together play a big part in this.

#### *More after school clubs*

This is always a tricky one as the school day is so full this is often the only time that staff have for meetings, training and their prep time. Many staff also have young children at home themselves and are unable to always commit to an after-school club. Where possible staff will hold clubs. EYFS have clubs in the Summer Term – for these children starting school is enough without adding clubs on top.

#### *Weekly updates on if a child has struggled with a specific topic or what has been taught in lessons*

Weekly updates are just not feasible – this would impact severely on staff time and wellbeing. If you look at the homework this will always reflect what the child has been learning in the class that week.

#### *Children need more homework in all years*

The best work you can do with your child at home is hear them read at least twice a week. Talk to them about their day – model those full sentences when speaking and

play games that involve turn taking. Explore the local environment and go to the local park. Written homework that goes out is in line with guidelines.

*Major accidents like head bumps should be informed with phone calls*

It is our policy that if a child bumps their head, then a phone call is made home.

*School menu should definitely change*

Our school dinners are well balanced and are cooked on site. Fruit and yoghurt are always available and we educate the children on making healthy choices.

*Separate children according to ability*

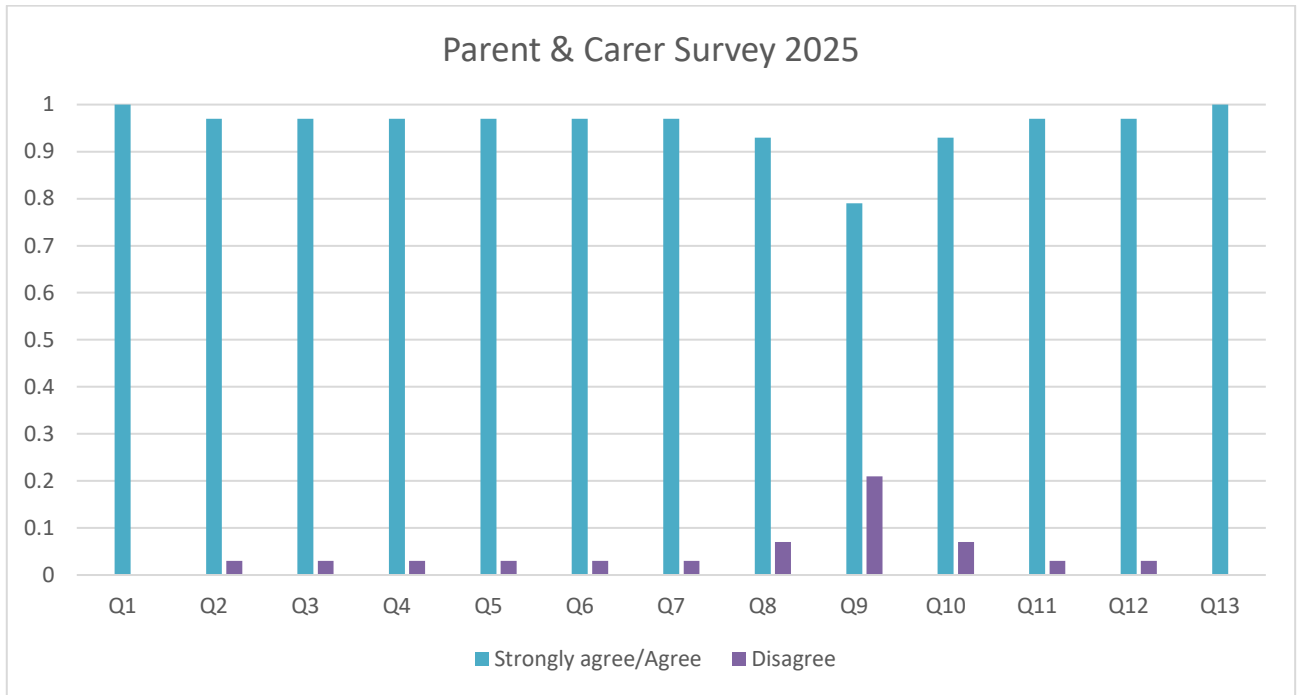
