Supporting Your Child in Year 3

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school, we hope you had a lovely Summer break. We hope, through this letter, to inform you of some of the curricular and other opportunities your child can expect this term. However, if there are things which are not covered, or questions you wish to ask, please feel free to get in touch.

Who are my teachers?

Mrs Lally will be teaching on Monday and Tuesday. Mrs Rudkin will be teaching Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Mrs Redfern will be covering PPA on a Wednesday afternoon.

P.E.

Your child will be taught two PE lessons a week. Children need to **wear** their PE kits to school on **Wednesday** for their lesson with the PE coach. They will also need to **wear** their PE kits to school on a **Friday** for their PE lesson with me. Please also note that **for all PE activities no jewellery whatsoever must be worn, including earrings and watches and long hair must be tied up, please ensure they come to school ready for PE including no earrings or earrings already taped.**



PE kit - white t shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms, PE jumpers must be their Langmoor blue school jumpers. Children need to be wearing trainers.

If your child cannot remove their own earrings, they need to come to school with their ears taped safely. **We will not be able to tape your child's ears.**

Uniform

Please could you ensure that children are in the correct uniform for the school day. Boys should wear grey or black trousers, a white shirt or polo shirt and a blue school jumper. You can either purchase a jumper or sweatshirt from Schoolwear solutions or buy a plain blue jumper from a shop. We sell iron on badges in the office. Boys may wear grey school shorts in the summer. Girls should wear grey skirts or pinafores, a white shirt or polo shirt and a blue school jumper or cardigan. Again these can either be purchased from Schoolwear solutions or a plain one bought and a badge ironed on. In the warmer months girls may also wear a blue checked dress. Can we also ask that where possible that children wear black or dark coloured shoes rather than trainers.

Snack

In KS2 the children need to bring their own snack into school. This must be a **healthy snack**, no nuts or chocolate. The children should bring in portioned **fruit or vegetables** for their snack. Children can continue to have water bottles in class **but they must be filled with water, no juice is allowed**. In KS2, milk is not available for all children. If you would like more information, please ask us, you will be able pay for your child to have milk but this must be set up with the office.



Pencil Cases

Children in Year 3 are welcome to bring a small pencil case if they would like to, though it isn't something they need. If they do choose to bring one, please make sure it's small enough to fit comfortably in their drawer. Don't worry—we provide all the essential equipment, so your child will have everything they need even without a pencil case.



Music

On Fridays, the children will be having whole class music tuition. We will be learning how to play the recorder. There will be an opportunity this term to watch the children in a performance.



Homework will be published on the **Purple Mash blog**, the 'Learning Logs' will continue in Key Stage 2 as a way to record any written work. Homework will be given out on a Friday and due in **on Wednesday**. Homework is explained to all children on a Friday in school time, if children need further explanations or help they should ask **before Wednesday or during homework club on Monday**, so that they can still hand it in on time. Children should be encouraged to work on their presentation but *express their answers freely in the form of words, drawings, photographs or however they choose to*.
