This survey helps school leaders understand what is working well and what we should improve so that every child can live, learn and laugh together. These answers will be used as part of our School self-assessment and shared with staff and governors when we plan improvements and prepare for OFSTED.

Here's what they had to say:

| 6. Behaviour in my lessons lets me learn without interruptions. | 46% |
| 7. The school helps me look after my physical and emotional health. | 65% |

| 9. The school helps me to respect people from different backgrounds and treat everyone fairly. | 73% |
